Tourism Authority Traineeship Program

Background

The Tourism Authority is a corporate body set up by the Tourism Authority Act 2006. The Authority has *inter-alia* the responsibility to:

- (i) License, regulate and supervise tourist enterprises;
- (ii) Register, license and regulate the use of pleasure crafts;
- (iii) License and supervise the activities of canvassers and skippers;
- (iv) Manage and develop tourist sites; and
- (v) Establish standards, guidelines and codes of practice in relation to the carrying on or running of a tourist enterprise, the operation of pleasure crafts, and the activities of a skipper.

Traineeship Scheme

The Tourism Authority has set up a traineeship scheme for young graduates, diploma and HSC holders.

The main objectives of the scheme are to:

- Offer training opportunities to unemployed school leavers (HSC), diploma holders and young graduates.
- Expose the young adults to the challenges of the tourism sector.
- Provide a substantive learning experience that serves as a basis for young unemployed adults to explore their career options and develop professional skills.
- Offer an opportunity for young people to get some work experience.
- Enable young people to contribute their knowledge to the organization.

Duration of Traineeship: 3-12 months.

Basic Requirements

The Scheme is open to **HSC**, **diploma and degree holders**

Core Competencies required

Result Oriented

Ability to integrate in teams

Learning and knowledge sharing

Excellent oral and written communication skills in English and French

Computer literate

Age Limit

Candidates should be aged between 18 to 30 years.

Stipend

The selected candidate will be paid an all-inclusive monthly stipend of:

Rs. 6,000 per month for HSC/GCE Advanced Level

Rs. 7,000 per month for diploma holders

Rs. 10,000 per month for graduates

NOTE: Trainees enlisted in this scheme will not have any claim to permanent appointment for any posts at the Tourism Authority. The traineeship scheme is also opened to unemployed persons with disabilities who are registered with the Training and Employment of Disabled Persons Board
