



Dolphin and Whale Watching

The Tourism Authority wishes to inform all commercial pleasure craft licensees that the Authority will be conducting training sessions for licensed skippers who wish to apply for a Certificate to operate "Dolphin and Whale Watching" as a commercial activity on a pleasure craft.

The training will be carried out in four batches over two consecutive days. Three sessions will be held in the western region and one in the northern region. On the second day of the training, participants will be required to sit for an oral multiple choice examination in creole.

Interested skippers are requested to submit their applications together with documents as per checklist by **Monday 27 November 2017**. The application form with the checklist and training details are available on the Tourism Authority's website <http://www.tourismauthority.mu/download/60.pdf> and at the Reception counter of the Tourism Authority on the 1st Floor, Victoria House, Corner Barracks and St Louis Streets, Port Louis.

Note: The "Certificate" is a legal requirement under the Tourism Authority (Dolphin and Whale Watching) Regulations 2012- GN 87 of 01 September 2012. If a commercial pleasure craft licensee provides dolphin and whale watching activity without a skipper holding a certificate to operate the craft, it would be considered as an offence.
