Any person who knowingly retains a duplicate licence /permit or without sufficient excuse, has in his possession an original licence/permit and its duplicate at the same time, shall commit an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding 10,000 rupees and to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months.
