- clear improvement actions undertaken in a time bound fashion

The ILO methodology also uses a baseline questionnaire that helps enterprises self-evaluate for themselves where they lack safety and areas which they might have overlooked.

A certificate will be awarded to trainers and beneficiary enterprises who have successfully implemented the project.
