

Tourism Authority (Pleasure Craft Licence Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 2007

THE TOURISM AUTHORITY ACT 2006

Regulations made by the Minister under section 129 of the Tourism Authority Act 2006

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Tourism Authority (Pleasure Craft Licence Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 2007**.

2. In these regulations -

"principal regulations" means the Tourism Authority (Pleasure Craft Licence Fees) Regulations 2007.

3. The Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by deleting items 8 and 9 and replacing them by the following items -

8. For the issue of a licence -

Length of pleasure craft	Private purpose Rs	Commercial purpose Rs
Not more than 6 metres.....	4,000	8,000
More than 6 metres but not more than 12 metres.....	6,000	12,000
More than 12 metres but not more than 20 metres.....	10,000	20,000
More than 20 metres.....	20,000	40,000

8A. (1) For the renewal of a licence issued prior to 30 June 2007 -

Length of pleasure craft	Private purpose Rs	Commercial purpose Rs
Not more than 6 metres.....	4,000	6,000
More than 6 metres but not more than 12 metres.....	6,000	8,000
More than 12 metres but not more than 20 metres.....	10,000	20,000
More than 20 metres.....	20,000	40,000

(2) For the renewal of a licence issued after 30 June 2007 -

Length of pleasure craft	Private purpose Rs	Commercial purpose Rs
Not more than 6 metres.....	4,000	8,000
More than 6 metres but not more than 12 metres.....	6,000	12,000
More than 12 metres but not more than 20 metres.....	10,000	20,000
More than 20 metres.....	20,000	40,000

9. For the issue of a duplicate licence -

Private purpose Rs	Commercial purpose Rs
1,500	1,500

4. Any licensee who has been issued a licence for a commercial purpose prior to 30 June 2007 shall -

- (a) at the commencement of these regulations, pay the fees specified in item 8A(1) of the Schedule; and
- (b) as from 1 May 2009, pay the fees specified in item 8A(2) of the Schedule.

5. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 May 2007.
